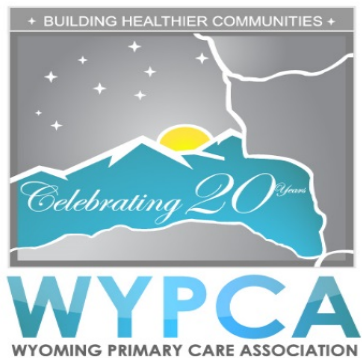

How does having health insurance impact student health?

- More likely to receive medical care
- More likely to receive better medical care
- More likely to live longer
- Helps reduce financial stress
- More likely to have a better quality of life (graduate from school, better job with higher wages, etc.)

- ▶ Educate about the Marketplace, Kid Care CHIP, Medicare, Medicaid and private insurance
- ▶ Provide fair and impartial information
- ▶ Educate about Coverage to Care to increase health literacy and promote preventive services
- ▶ Protect Privacy and Security of Personal Identifiable Information (PII)

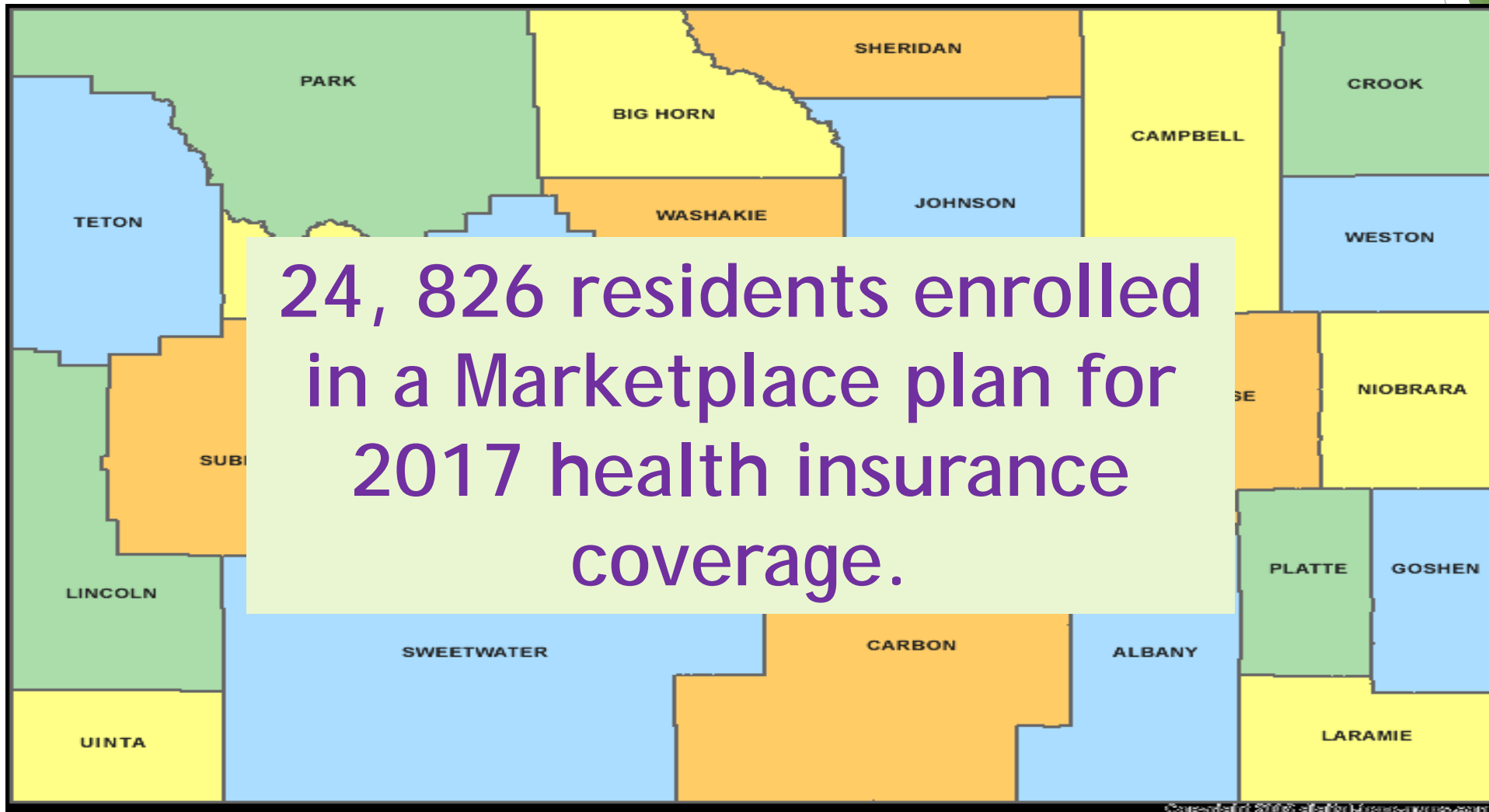

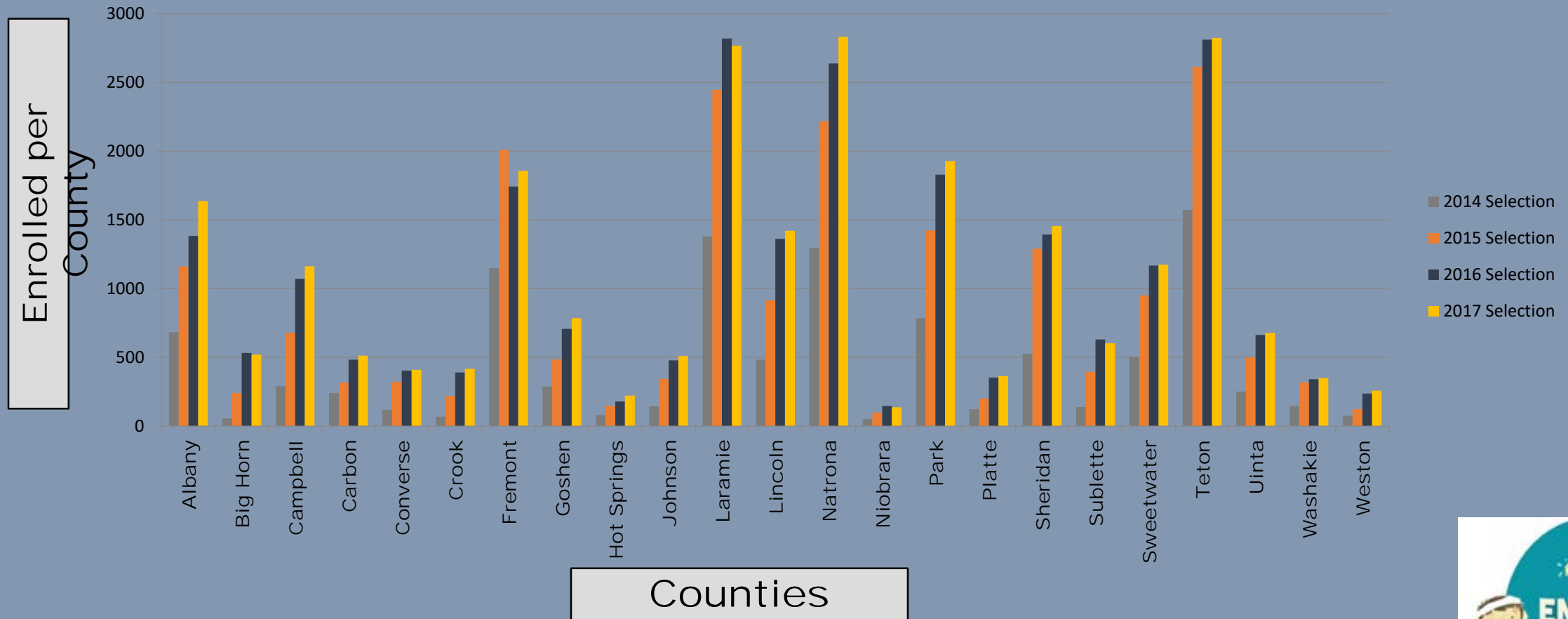


The Enrollment Challenge

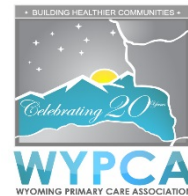
Create Opportunities for Students to Keep Wyoming Strong

- Policy-sharing information and marketing restrictions (even if there are no financial costs).
- Timing- Meeting families where they are is an art.
- Lack of Knowledge
- Language Barriers
- Fear

Use social media

- Use the school's Twitter and Facebook

- Put information in the school or classroom newsletter

Reach out to colleagues

- Give the school nurse a place in the staff meeting
- Set up a health and wellness leadership team
- Reach out to all school employees

Connect with parents

- Collaborate with the PTA
- Invite a CAC or navigator to parent night to help parents sign up
- Put information in Friday food bags
- Find a health and wellness champion in the parent community

Organize students

- Projects for service groups: Key Club, Interact, 4-H
- Classroom projects
