SUBJECT: Potential Lead in Water

AVAILABLE EPA TECHNICAL RESOURCE FOR SCHOOLS

The EPA has released a new information assistance program to support schools in monitoring and keeping lead in drinking water at minimal levels. It is called the 3T Program: Training, Testing, and Telling.
