

Paper Testing Allowable Resource Guidelines

The Wyoming Tests of Proficiency and Progress (WY-TOPP) are standardized assessments, used for school and district accountability determinations, and must be administered in a standardized manner. The assessments measure a student’s mastery of academic knowledge and skills as defined in the Wyoming Content and Performance Standards in ELA and mathematics at grades 3–10 and science at grades 4, 8, and 10. The following chart contains the only materials or resources to be used by students during the assessment. Use of any other resources (human, electronic, manipulative, or paper) will be considered an unethical assessment administration practice that may lead to invalidated test results.
