## ALLOWABLE RESOURCE GUIDELINES

The Wyoming Test of Proficiency and Progress (WY-TOPP) are standardized assessments, used for school and district accountability determinations, and must be administered in a standardized manner. The assessments measure a student's mastery of academic knowledge and skills as defined in the Wyoming Content and Performance Standards (WYCPS) in ELA and mathematics in grades 3-10 and science in grades 4, 8, and 10. The following chart contains the only materials or resources that may be used by students during the WY-TOPP assessments. Use of any other resources (human, electronic, manipulative, or paper) will be considered an unethical assessment administration practice and may lead to invalidated test results.
